ORDER*

The State of Wyoming appealed a May 18, 2022, decision issued by the Bureau of Land Management approving the acquisition of the Marton Ranch property in Natrona and Carbon Counties, Wyoming. After the State filed a statement of reasons in support of its appeal, BLM filed a motion to set aside and remand its decision so that it can “reevaluate its May 18, 2022, decision, provide additional opportunities for public notice and comment, and supplement its environmental analysis to better address issues raised by the Appellant in the Statement of Reasons.”¹ BLM represents that the State does not oppose the motion.²

Based on BLM’s representations, we set aside its May 18, 2022, decision and remand the matter for appropriate action.
